CASE for Kids *City Connections*, funded directly by the City of Houston, supports organizations that address the need for youth services outside the school day. Projects funded by the CASE for Kids *City Connections* program take place in a variety of locations including schools, community centers, apartment complexes, and churches. Grants are designed to meet individual Houston city council district needs and provide prevention-based programming that addresses gaps in services to youth.

CASE for Kids received a total of 105 *City Connections* applications for the September 7, 2016 deadline requesting a total of **\$843,125** in funding for a variety of out-of-school time programs in the city of Houston. Each council district had a grants budget of \$45,000. The organizations listed above will provide diverse activities for youth after school including fine arts, academic enrichment, college exploration, and fitness classes.

Individual applicants from the September 2016 group will be notified the week of October 10, 2016 in regards to the next steps in the application process.
