

FUNDING ANNOUNCEMENT

The nonprofit organizations listed below have been awarded a **2017-2018 City Connections** (CC) grant award. Funding for the **City Connections** project is provided by the **City of Houston** and administered by the Center for Afterschool, Summer and Enrichment for Kids or CASE for Kids, a division of Harris County Department of Education. A total of 97 CC applications were received requesting \$1,021,400 in funding. Eleven district council members receive \$45,000 in funding for grant awards. Please note, as indicated by the asterisk symbol (*), some council districts exercised their option to increase their overall grants budget this year.
