



CASE FOR KIDS 2018-2019 CITY CONNECTIONS GRANTEES

The nonprofit organizations listed below have been awarded a **2018-2019 City Connections** (CC) grant award. Funding for the **City Connections** project is provided by the **City of Houston** and administered by the Center for Afterschool, Summer and Enrichment for Kids or CASE for Kids, a division of Harris County Department of Education. A total of 109 applications were received requesting \$1,297,875 in funding. Eleven district council members award \$45,000 each, in funding for CC grants.
