CASE for Kids announces 2015 Out-of-School Time Conference Sept. 25 and 26
3rd annual event gathers out-of-school time, expanded learning leaders for conversations, connections, professional development at The Westin Houston, Memorial City

CASE for Kids, a division of Harris County Department of Education, hosts the 2015 CASE for Kids Out-of-School Time Conference on Sept. 25 and 26 at The Westin Houston, 945 Gessner Road in Memorial City, Houston, Texas. The 3rd annual event gathers leading out-of-school time and expanded learning professionals in one location for a two-day journey that sparks deep conversations and establishes lifelong connections. The conference that adopts the belief that “every minute matters” is packed with unique, energy-charged professional development activities.



Keynote speakers and presenters provide workshops that are designed to be applicable to any youth program, including schools, child care centers and community centers.

Cost for the two-day conference is \$100, including all meals. Price is \$75 for Friday, including the sit-down, “State of After-School” luncheon and beverage station. Registration for only the luncheon is \$50. The Saturday event is \$25.

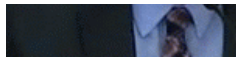
